ENTRIES

- 1. Entrants must currently live, work, study or base their creative practice in Darebin (ie. your studio is in Darebin).
- 2. All works submitted must be original work by the person whose name appears on the entry form and completed between 2021-2023.
- 3. Entrants must confirm their artwork does not, to the best of their knowledge, infringe on the intellectual or moral rights of another person or organisation.
- 4. All artworks must be no larger than A1 (59.4 x 84.1cm) **inclusive** of any frames or backing boards. They must be able to hung on a wall and be able to be lifted by two people.
- 5. If your work is heavier than 5kg, please contact Bundoora Homestead Art Centre on 03 9496 1060 to discuss the eligibility of your work.
- 6. Entry forms are to be submitted online via the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre website by midday on Friday 3 February 2023. If you need assistance, you may visit the Gallery during opening hours for staff to assist you.
- 7. The artwork submitted via the entry form must be the artwork delivered. No substitutes will be accepted. Supplied images of the artwork must accurately represent the final artwork.
- 8. Entry to the Salon is free of charge.
- 9. Employees of Darebin City Council, Councillors and members of the Darebin Art and Heritage Advisory Panel are ineligible to enter the Salon.
- 10. Entrants must not post or deliver any physical support material for their entry.
- 11. Only one artwork may be submitted per person.
- 12. Entrants can be of any age.
- 13. Bundoora Homestead Art Centre reserves the right to refuse an artwork should it be deemed offensive, defamatory, or infringing on the intellectual or moral rights of another.
- 14. Due to limited space at the Gallery, only the first 150 works submitted will be accepted.

EXHIBITION

- 15. Entrants' work must arrive at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre between 11am-4pm on Wednesday 1 March Saturday 4 March. Artworks not delivered during this period will not be hung in the exhibition or presented for judging.
- 16. Entrants' work must be suitably framed and ready to hang or otherwise prepared for display. Framed works must be fitted with D-rings so that they can be hung on wires. Alternatively, unframed works needs to be light enough that they can be mounted to walls using magnets or pins. If works are still wet, they will not be accepted.
- 17. Works must be labelled with the entrant's name and title of work. The entrant's name and artwork title must match the details submitted in the application form. No changes can be made after the entry form is submitted.
- 18. Any works damaged in transit to the gallery, or delivered without an appropriate hanging system will not be exhibited.

- 19. All selected works must be available for display throughout the duration of the exhibition.
- 20. The gallery staff will install all artworks at their discretion. As it is a Salon hang, works may be hung at different heights and in close proximity to one another. Unfortunately, The Gallery cannot accommodate special installation requests for this exhibition.

SALES

21. No commission on sales is taken. The Gallery will not coordinate artwork sales, however we will collect interested buyers' contact details and forward the information through to the entrant. It is the entrant's responsibility to process artwork sales and hand over sold artworks to the buyer after the conclusion of the exhibition.

INSURANCE

- 22. Darebin City Council provides insurance for loss or damage suffered to a work while in its possession. Insurance values for lost or damaged works will be honoured, subject to an independent valuation for said work. Bundoora Homestead Art Centre takes all care to safeguard the artworks. However, by submitting a work for exhibition, you accept the potential risk of artworks being touched or damaged by members of the public.
- 23. Bundoora Homestead Art Centre does not insure works in transit to or from the gallery.

FREIGHT

24. Any freight and courier costs related to the delivery of artworks must be paid by the entrant. Entries will not be received by the Gallery unless freight has been paid in full. No payment will be made by The Gallery for freight or any other charge incurred in the delivery and/or return of any work submitted.

REPRODUCTION OF WORKS

25. Copyright of the artwork remains the property of the entrant. Entrant's permit Council to reproduce their artwork by print or electronic/social media for publicity purposes, reports, catalogues and any other publications related to the A1 Darebin Art Salon for a period of five years from the closing date of the exhibition. Due attribution will be made to the entrant.

PRIZES

- 26. Judging for the Exhibiting Award as part of the A1 Salon Prize will include two independent experts from the art sector in Victoria and the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre Curator. One exhibiting entrant will be awarded the Exhibiting Award. The Exhibiting Award Winner will be given the opportunity to present a solo exhibition at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre in 2024-2025. The exhibition may be offered in any gallery space at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre at the discretion of the Curator.
- 27. Four People's Choice Awards will be awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Painting
 - b. Photography
 - c. Drawing/printmaking
 - d. Textile/mixed media

The People's Choice Awards will be judged by visitors to the gallery and will be announced at the conclusion of the exhibition. The Winner of each category will be awarded a small prize. Darebin City Council reserve the right not to award these prizes if no artworks are submitted under any of the specified prize categories.

COLLECTION OF WORKS

28. The exhibition will open on Wednesday 15 March 2023 and close on Saturday 24 June 2023. Entries are to be collected from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre on either Sunday 25 June, Monday 26 June or Tuesday 27 June 2023 between the hours of 11am and 4pm. If works have not been collected by 4pm Tuesday 27 June, The Gallery reserves the right to dispose of the works.
