The frame of netball was partly inspired by my own memories of playing as a child, and by more recent experiences of attending my step-daughter's netball games when she was a child. It struck me as such a rich space to delve into questions around being a woman and being with other women.

For a while the show was going to be about an elite team but the more it developed, the more it seemed to fit in a world of amateur sports, of suburban dreaming and within older bodies.

It has been an epic work to create and produce. So many people have contributed along the way, with their skills and time. The development of the work crossed over with my own experience of a cancer diagnosis and treatment. So the themes of bodies, endurance, vulnerability and aging have been sharply resonant.

Thank you to our team of incredibly hard working actors, creatives and crew – all of whom have taken a risk on making a work with an untested form. Contest sits somewhere between a play and a poem, it's an argument, an elegy and a dream. Which is all well and good for me to say but I know has not been easy to make!

And so my final, wholesome, heartfelt thanks to our fearless and fabulous director Prue Clark who has shepherded this beast into existence.
