Darebin Arts Speakeasy is an award-winning year-long program. It supports innovative new works presented by small and medium arts organisations, companies and independent artists. The program spans dance, circus, theatre and multi-disciplinary work that speaks to issues that matter to the community and celebrates cultural diversity.

Darebin has long been home to artists and creatives. Over the last 11 years, Speakeasy has provided opportunities to some incredibly talented people, many of them local to Darebin.

Since 2013, Speakeasy has supported over 1,500 artists to create over 150 original works presented to roughly 80,000 patrons, receiving 45 creative industry awards and a further 125 nominations. The program brings Northcote Town Hall Arts Centre and Darebin Arts Centre to life with thrilling artistic presentations. The 2024 season features First Nations-led works, diverse local voices, fierce environmentalism and access for all.

It is not just a play; it's a testament to the intersection of global events and personal experiences, where the enormity of what's happening in the world collides with the intimate journeys of individual lives.

From its inception, *Future Proof* has undergone a transformative journey of its own. What began as a narrative with fully-formed characters and linear journeys soon evolved into something more fluid, more reflective of the pace and complexity of our contemporary existence. The decision to allow performers to dive into scenes and let them go mirrors the struggle of ideas to gain traction in a world that's constantly evolving.

For me, *Future Proof* is like a living venn diagram, with its focus on people, place, and power. While the term 'future proofing' often conjures images of corporate strategies and technological advancements, I believe its true essence lies in safeguarding the well-being of individuals and communities, free from the distortions of power.

When we embarked on this journey in 2016, there was a sense of urgency, a feeling that we needed to capture the essence of the times before it slipped away. Yet, here we are, seven years later, and the relevance of *Future Proof* has only deepened. As the world continues to grapple with ever-evolving challenges, the themes of this production resonate even more profoundly.

I hope this performance sparks conversations, inspires introspection, and perhaps offers glimpses of hope amidst the complexities of our shared journey.

Founded in 2014, Gravity Dolls has garnered a reputation for their multidisciplinary approach, fusing contemporary circus, physical theatre, and original writing. Under the visionary leadership of Tim Rutty and Harlow Carey, Gravity Dolls has crafted a unique artistic practice rarely seen in Australia.


Their debut show, *My Life in Boxes*, premiered at the Melbourne Fringe Festival in 2014. It won the Original New Circus Award supported by Circus Oz, runner-up at the Gasworks Circus Showdown before interstate and regional tours. They were the first circus company to be programmed in Poppy Seed Theatre Festival with Level Up. In 2022 *Future Proof* premiered at the Arts Centre Melbourne, commissioned by the Springboard Program.

Gravity Dolls also runs their own circus studio in Northcote. It is home to a year-round short-course circus program for adults and a number of other programs for professional artists.


