Getting to Darebin Arts Centre

By Bus

Bus Route 513, 514, 903 (get off at St Georges Road/Bell Street)

For help planning your tram, train or bus trip use the <u>PTV</u> journey planner.

If you're taking the 903 bus from the city, you'll want to get off at the Bell St/St Georges Rd stop (Stop 14).

> This stop is right at the corner of Bell St and St Georges Rd, where the Darebin Arts Centre is located.

> > From the stop, you can walk straight across Bell St to the Arts Centre entrance.

It's a short, level walk of about 30 meters.

Arriving by Tram

86 Bundoora RMIT -Waterfront City Docklands Get off at the Bell Street/Plenty Rd stop (Stop 35)

Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing

Walk approximately 100m along Bell Street until you see Darebin Arts


Centre on the corner.

Get off at the Miller St/St Georges Rd stop

Walk north for about 10 minutes until you get to Bell St.

Darebin Arts Centre will be on the right.

By Train: Take the Mernda line to Bell Station.

As you exit the station, head north towards Bell St and turn left.
Walk for about 150 meters on Bell St.
Darebin Arts Centre will be on your left.

Arriving By Car

There is a large accessible carpark at the front of the venue entry via Bell St (turn left off Peter St).

The closest Disabled Parking is out the front near the main glass entry doors.

Entering The Main Building

At Darebin Arts Centre Arts Centre, the main entrance is up the steps at the front of the building off the car park.

There are three steps equipped with grab rails and tactile surface indicators at the top and bottom of each step.

This entrance has a set of glass automatic doors leading to an airlock, followed by another set of glass automatic doors that provide entry to the venue.

These doors are locked prior to the performance and are opened by Darebin Arts Centre staff 45 minutes before the performance.

The main entrance glass doors to the street will be closed when the performance begins but can always be opened by staff if you need to leave during a performance.

The Box Office

Once inside, the box office is a couple of metres in front of you to the left.

Here, our welcoming front of house staff will be available to provide any help you need.

Ushers will be wearing black clothing and have a lanyard like this.



Toilets

The toilets are past the right-side box office.


And the toilets from the outside a bit

There are male, female, all gender and accessible toilets. There are hand also dryers.

The limited turning space in baby changing room may make it unsuitable for larger motorised wheelchairs or mobility scooters.

There is a baby change room in the foyer to the left of the Box Office.



The Bar




Image: The bar in the foyer area

Drinks and snacks can be bought at the bar and taken into the theatre.

There is a lower section of the bar which is wheelchair accessible.

The bar accepts card only, not cash.

The Doors to the Theatre

When the performers are ready, the ushers will announce that the 'house is open'. They will open the doors to the Theatre, and you may enter at your own pace.

Upon entering the Theatre, you will walk through a curtain split. The seating bank will be on the left. The seating bank is tiered and access to upper levels is by a central aisle with stairs. Wheelchair seating is in the front row.

An Usher can help you find your seat if you would like some help.
